CLASS PLACEMENT POLICY

Rationale

Class placements for students follow principles and practices consistent with the Curriculum Framework, current legislation and DET policies and Strategic Planning. They are undertaken by staff, collectively, and overseen by Administration.

Purpose

2. To enable appropriately suitable placement of students.
3. To enhance learning engagement.
4. To maximise support.
5. To provide continuity of relationships via composite class and sub school structures.
6. To enable educational, social, emotional and behavioural development.

Broad Guidelines

Class placements are undertaken collectively by staff and finalised by Administration, with consideration given to specific criteria:

1. Special needs
2. Education needs
3. Behavioural needs
4. Social and emotional needs
5. Balanced student groupings

Special requests by teachers and parents pertaining to evidence based educational needs are considered during placement, if relevant.
