SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Rationale:

A school's dress code can play an important role in promoting a positive image of the school and creating a sense of identity. Wearing the school uniform is strongly encouraged, with the support of parents. However observance of the dress code is not a condition for enrolment.

Purpose:

1. To foster and enhance the public image of the school.
2. To assist in building school and team spirit.
3. To encourage equity among students.
4. To prepare students for work, as many work places have dress and safety codes.

Broad Guidelines:

1. The development of the Dress Code is the responsibility of the School Council. Changes to the code will require school community consultation.
2. The P&C will operate a Uniform Shop at the school for the sale of new uniform. Second hand uniforms may also be available.

Conclusion:

The Dress Code is subject to regular review and is a separate document.

Summer:

School Polo Shirt – Gold
Gold with pin stripes (Years 6/7)
Grey Shorts (As displayed in the Uniform Shop, No Cargo Pants)
Grey Skirts/Shorts/School Dress - as displayed in Uniform Shop
Appropriate Footwear
Rugby Top Yr 6/7
School Cap/Hat (Broad Brimmed Green is encouraged for all)

Winter

Tracksuit Pants
Grey Slacks/Pants/School Dress - as displayed in Uniform Shop
Windcheater/Spray Jacket - as displayed in Uniform Shop
Appropriate Footwear

Note: All children require a hat for outdoor play and activities, especially in Terms 1 & 4, subject to weather, activities and general common sense related to practicality and safety.
