Ms Stephanie Buitenhuis, Program Co-ordinator, and Mrs Louise Merrilees, Media Advisor, of The Smith Family visited our school assembly on Friday 1 June. We had the privilege of hearing first-hand the work the Smith Family do to improve educational outcomes for disadvantaged young Australians. Ms Buitenhuis told the story of the origins of The Smith Family.

On Christmas Eve 1922, five businessmen walked into a Sydney orphanage carrying armfuls of toys and sweets. They walked out inspired by a single goal: to improve the lives of disadvantaged children in Australia. When the workers at the orphanage asked the businessmen their names, wishing to remain anonymous, they simply answered The Smith Family.

Our School Captains, Jasmina & Preston, School Councillors, Anna & Ellyse, along with our Wellbeing Captains Esmæ & Farham were fabulous hosts to our guests on the day. Farham introduced and thanked the ladies for visiting and Esmæ presented them with a Certificate of Appreciation which is now displayed in the reception area of their head office in East Perth. It was a joy to donate \$766.00 raised on Rainbeau Friday to assist others less fortunate. **Thank you for your support and generosity.**

KINDERGARTEN APPLICATIONS 2019

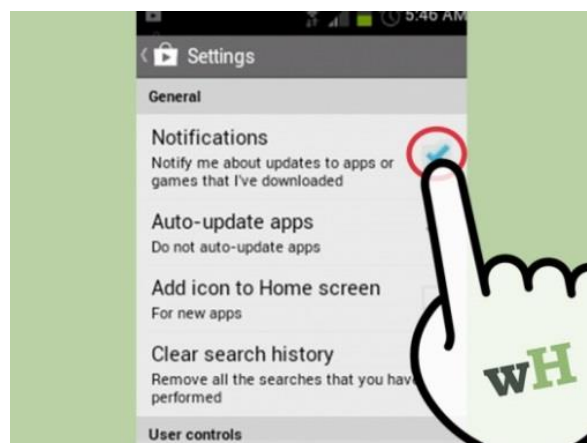
If you have a child turning four in 2019 by the 30th June, 2019, then they will be eligible for a place in our Program.
