

YEAR 6 CAMP & EVENTS FOR GRADUATION

Dear Parents/Caregivers

CAMP

The countdown is on for the Year 6 Camp to Camp Mornington. Supervision of our students will be provided by all our Year 6 teachers, Mrs Stewart, Mrs Greeshaw, Mrs Kane AND Ms Blackwell, Mr Sugrue, Mrs Letcher, Mrs Maples and Mr Green.



Medication - Any **non-urgent** medication (nurofen, Panadol, antihistamines etc) needs to be handed to your child's class teacher **no later than Thursday 25th October** in a zip up plastic bag. Please label all medication and the zip up bag clearly, along with appropriate dosage.

All other medications, including Epipens, asthma medications should be given to Mrs Greeshaw on arrival to school on the day of our departure. Please place in a zip up plastic bag, clearly marked with student's name.

What to Bring - Refer to the "What you need to Bring" brochure. Copy on the School website for your reference. All clothing and toiletries must be labelled and should be packed in a **MEDIUM** size carry bag or suitcase. It is also advisable that bedding, sleeping bag, fitted sheet and extra blanket be packed within the bag or suite case, or attached securely to the bag or suite case.

A **SMALL** backpack is required for the bus to ensure that students have access to their morning tea, water bottle and other items such as a book to read and their pencil case.

Students have been reminded that mobile phones/ipods etc are **NOT PERMITTED** on camp. If you need to contact your child whilst they are away, please call the school. After hours, please contact Mornington Adventure Camp on 9729 2236 and leave a message if no answer. Please be advised that there is **NO MOBILE** coverage at the Camp venue.

Departure

Students are to meet at the front of the school (near staff car park off Beaumaris Boulevard) at **7:00am on Tuesday 30 OCTOBER**, with all luggage clearly labelled and ready for loading onto the bus.

We will be departing at 7:30am sharp, so please ensure you are prompt in arriving at school. We plan to arrive at the Mornington Adventure Camp at approximately 11am. Our anticipated arrival time back to school on **Friday 2nd November will be around 3:00pm**.

If your child is inclined to suffer from travel sickness, please inform one of the staff members so they can monitor your child for the trip down and back.

Students are NOT required to wear their school uniform at any time whilst on camp. The students need to wear items that are comfortable and appropriate to the planned activities on the day.

GRADUATION CEREMONY

The Graduation Ceremony is being held on **Wednesday 12 December** in the school's Assembly area from 8:30am to approximately 10:30am. Students are to wear their full school uniform (no Leavers shirts). The invitation is open to all parents of our 2018 Year 6 students to attend.
