

# Drawing: Exquisite Corpse

Year 5 & 6

This week you will practise drawing with **lines**, **shapes** and adding **texture**, whilst playing a fun game!

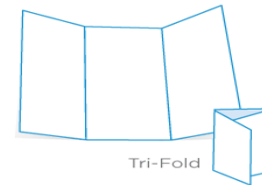
## You will need:

- A4 paper
- Drawing pencil
- Fine Liner or Black Marker
- 2 family members
- Device with a camera & Seesaw app



## Step 1

Fold A4 paper into thirds, like in the video. In the top third, draw an imaginative head & neck. Make sure to extend the bottom lines for the next person. Add extra **details** and **texture**, to make it more interesting.

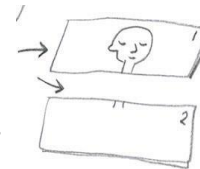


## Vocabulary:

Pattern, Shading, Detail, Uniform, Exquisite Corpse

## Step 2

Fold the top third over so that it is hidden. Pass the paper to the second person to draw the body & arms into the middle third, extending the lines for the third person.

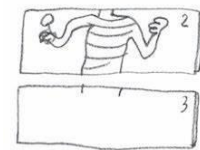


## Elements of Art:

Line, Shape, Space, Texture

## Step 3

Fold the middle third over so that it is hidden. Pass the paper to the third person to draw the legs & feet. When finished, open your Exquisite Corpse drawing!

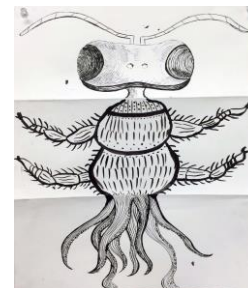


## Step 4

Outline your drawing, to make it more **uniform**, whilst adding a variety of **lines** to create extra **detail & texture**.

Take a **photo** and upload to **Seesaw**.
