



## BEAUMARIS PRIMARY SCHOOL 2022 CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

The Beaumaris Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2021. These are costs associated with providing quality educational opportunities for our students and these are outlined below. When planning some months in advance, we cannot be sure of exact costs, but we hope the estimates provided below, will assist parents in budgeting for these possible expenses.

Please note, that some costs indicated below, will only apply to certain students. For example, not all students will be part of the Instrumental Music Program or attend PEAC. Inter/School competitions include athletics, touch rugby etc. A summary of the schedule is below, followed by more detailed information.

1. The <b>School Voluntary Contribution</b> of \$60 per child from Yrs K-6,
2. Other monies payable as per the <b>Schedule of Charges</b> for each year level.
3. The <b>Items for Personal Use</b> lists as sent home. (K, PP, Yrs 1-6).

### **1. SCHOOL VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION (Kindergarten to Year 6 inclusive)**

The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been contained within the \$60.00 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000. Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure. Whilst contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments.

### **2. SCHEDULE OF CHARGES**

Information collected in relation to charges in previous years has informed our 2022 Charges Schedule. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. **The amounts indicated on the attached schedule represents the maximum charged for scheduled activities in 2021 and in reality some of these areas will work out to be less.** You will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches or you can make an upfront payment for the year. The Charges Schedule includes costs associated with:

*Specific learning activities available to all students but conditional on a payment being made (e.g. incursions, excursions, swimming etc)*

**OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES** - *There are a number of other activities that are purely optional and which only become a cost according to your personal choice. These include things such as School photographs, some science out of school activities and fundraising events.*

*Specific learning activities available to selected students but conditional on a payment being made e.g. PEAC, Performing Arts Program, Instrumental Music etc. PEAC (charges vary from \$10 to \$300 per student depending on course selection) and Instrumental Music \$150.00.*

**3. ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE IN THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM**

The charge for personal use items will vary from student to student and includes:

Pupil requirements for all students and used in lessons.	e.g. stationery items as per K, PP and Yrs 1-6 requirement lists.
Pupil requirements recommended but not essential for all students.	e.g. art shirt or other pay as you order or use.
Pupil requirements for selected students and not directly part of the educational program.	e.g. Leavers t-shirt, class photographs or other pay as you order or use.

We have negotiated competitive prices for the materials on pupil requirement lists but you are not obliged to use our supplier. Parents are reminded that students will need to have the listed materials each school day so it may be necessary to replace some items such as pencils throughout the year.
