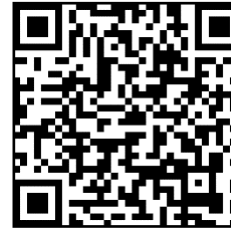


Found Objects: Colour Wheel

Year 1 & 2

Learn about **Colour Theory** by creating your own **Colour Wheel**, made from objects found in your home and garden!

You will need:

- Colourful found household & garden objects
- A large neutral coloured area for a background (floor, table, large piece of white paper etc.)
- Device with a camera & Seesaw app



Step 1

Start with the **Primary Colours** and space your objects at equal distance apart, in the shape of a circle. See the next page for examples.

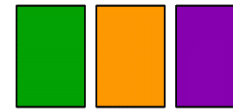


Vocabulary:

Colour, Primary, Secondary, Warm, Cool, Background, Foreground

Step 2

Move onto the **Secondary Colours** and place the found objects in between the correct **Primary Colours**, around the circle.

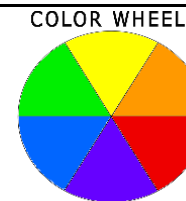


Elements of Art:

Step 3

Keep adding more found objects to fill in the gaps, until you have a complete **Colour Wheel**. See the next page for examples.
